We bid a very sad farewell to our beloved music director, Bill Cooper. Bill was a talented musician, passionate conversationalist, and the heart and soul of the East Bay Banjo Club. He passed away unexpectedly at his home, the Flying Pig Ranch, in Martinez, CA, on April 4, 2013. Our club is heartbroken and will endeavor to keep the club going in his memory.

Bill's passion for the banjo and traditional jazz music inspired many, many others to learn and then promote the joys and happiness the banjo brings to the world. He raised the spirits of countless numbers of people while leading the club on stage and during practice. Bill was always professional, in front of audiences both large and small, and he made every group he performed with into a class act. He accepted and encouraged banjo players of all skill levels to practice and perform the music he and the audiences loved. Bill was not only a highly accomplished banjo player, but arranged all the music for the club. His rich collection of arrangements will be played to the delight of audiences for years to come.

Bill was a lifelong resident of Martinez, CA. He took up the plectrum banjo at age 12 and never put it down. He accepted the post of Music Director of the East Bay Banjo Club in 1978 and has been its enthusiastic Music Director and lead player ever since. Bill also performed with the Toot Sweet Jazz Band, and they, too, will miss him terribly.

Bill spent several years practicing law and the remainder of his career was spent as a creative and patient teacher of special education students, until he retired in 2009. He touched the lives of everyone who knew him with his excitement, joy, kindness, and encouragement, as well as with his sense of humor.


