Guidelines Offered For EBBC Music Directors

EBBC could use one or two more assistant music directors. We are looking for volunteers from our membership. We also are considering other ideas, such as possibly hiring an experienced band leader to attend one or more practices a month and serve as our official leader for practices.

The music director (affectionately known as "MD") is the most important role in EBBC. At the moment, we don't have a permanent MD, and while we have several assistant MD's, they aren't always able to attend. We would love to have a couple more assistant MDs at our service.

The music director's function is to coordinate the music for the club at practices and playouts and to be the club's representative at playouts. Club members need to be open, patient and flexible in helping the music director plan for successful playouts because the playouts are paid for by the client, and the music director may need to alter the arrangements for some songs for the good of the event.

To ensure a standard procedure for playouts, a volunteer music director should follow the guidelines listed below.

- Create a preliminary list of songs for the playout, asking the club members for input, and suggest songs that fit the playout theme.
- Ask each member signed up for the playout if there is a song on the list they would like to perform as either vocal or solo. Club members interested in doing this should choose a song they are comfortable with.
- Arrange the song order to mix up the instrumentals, vocals and tempos. Variety is important for performances.
- Provide copies of the final set list to the club members at least two weeks in advance if possible. This allows time for the club members to practice the songs.
- Coordinate seating at the playout with rhythm players in the rear and soloists or lead players in the front.
- For each song the music director should ask if someone would like to play the intro. An intro establishes the tempo (speed) for the song. Tempos are critical for the vocalists and for the bass player. The vocalists and bassist can tell the tempo by listening to the intro—provided the intro stays in a steady tempo and doesn't speed up or slow down. Consistent tempos are critical!
